Warren R. Miller, 86, died peacefully on Tuesday December 22, 2009 at Valley View Nursing Home in Norwich.

He was born July 20, 1923 in South Edmeston, NY the son of Lynn W. and Eva May (Morten) Miller. He married Helen Anderson on May 10, 1947 at the Second Baptist Church in Edmeston. She predeceased Warren on March 31, 2003.

Warren retired from Simmons Precision where he was employed in the Aeronautic Division. In the 1960's he was a team member that developed a rocket igniter that culminated with the Lunar Modular landing on the moon. In his private life Warren served as a deacon for the Second Baptist Church, participated with his wife, Helen in the local bowling league, and volunteered for "Meals on Wheels". He was an avid golfer and baseball fan. As an amateur archeologist Warren has amassed a large Indian artifact collection that he donated to the Edmeston Museum.
